| A14-A1307 Embankment repairs and Huntingdon Road Bridge refurbishment in both directions.                                       | The A14 will be closed overnight to re-install the temporary safety barrier, which will then enable work to continue with just one lane closed. Work will continue 24/7 under a 40mph speed restriction with one lane closed and the other lane still open to traffic. | <p>During the overnight road closure of the A14 westbound, traffic will be diverted south east on the A1307 Huntingdon Road to the B1049 where it will travel north to junction 32 of the 14, then west on the A14 to the A428 exiting on to the A14 westbound where the diversion ends.</p> <p>During the closure of the A14 eastbound, traffic will continue east on the A14 to junction 32 (Histon) and then south on the B1049 to Huntingdon road then travel north west where the diversion will end.</p> |
| A14 Huntingdon Road Grange Farm geotechnical repair of embankment slope between Beck Brook and Grange Farm/Elm Grange Cottages. | Some overnight lane closures.  | N/A – the A14 will remain open with lane closures in place.  |
| A14 junction 33 embankment repairs.   | Some overnight lane closures to carry out survey works, vegetation clearance and installation of the earthworks machinery.   | N/A – the A14 will remain open with lane closures in place.  |
| A14 junctions 31 to 34 central reserve barrier renewal.   | There will be lane closures overnight during the works. During the day there will be a 40mph speed restriction in place due to sections of incomplete safety barrier.  | N/A – the A14 will remain open with lane closures in place.  |
| M11 junction 13 northbound exit slip resurfacing.   | The exit slip road will be fully closed over 5 consecutive weekends from Friday night to Monday morning. There will also be a lane closure on the M11 northbound after the exit slip road.   | Northbound traffic will continue north on the M11 to junction 14 and head east on the A14 to junction 32, returning westbound on the A14 to the A428 and then to the entry slip from the A1303 where the diversion ends. Traffic wishing to return to the A1303 Madingley Road will continue to the Hardwick junction taking the exit and return east on the A428 to the Madingley exit slip, where the diversion ends.  |
| M11 junction 13 southbound entry slip resurfacing.  | The exit slip road will be fully closed on Monday 25 and Tuesday 26 January. There will also be a lane closure on the M11 southbound at the exit slip road   | Southbound traffic will take the A1303 towards Cambridge, head south on the A1135, then take the A603 to re-join the M11 at junction 12.   |
| A14 River Cam bridge repairs at junction 34.  | The A14 eastbound will be closed from Monday 1 to Monday 7 February.   | <p>Traffic will exit at junction 33, taking the A10 north to Streetham and then east on the A1123, passing through Wicken to Fordham, then taking the A142 south to re-join the A14 at junction 37 (Newmarket).</p> <p>Traffic for junction 32 will turn around to go west on the A14 to junction 35, exit and take the A1303 west and then head north on the B1047.</p>   |
