

## HASLINGFIELD PARISH COUNCIL

### Traffic Calming – Phase 3

The Parish Council and the Working Group have been looking at the next phase of traffic calming in the village.

Draft plans have now been drawn up for Phase 3 of the villages' traffic calming scheme, see copy attached. To see a larger A3 version of the scheme, plans will be put on the Barton Road and Village Hall noticeboards. If Phase 3 is implemented, it would be important to complete both routes around the village (New Road and High Street/Church Street) at the same to prevent the other route becoming a 'rat-run'. Phase 3 of the scheme has to come as a 'whole', we cannot implement part of it and not another. Also, the placing of all of the proposed traffic calming schemes cannot be changed. These plans have been declared practical and legal by both SCDC and Skanska.

The total cost of the scheme will be £52,000, (including the cost of the Barton Road scheme at £12,000 which we have already agreed to proceed with). All traffic calming costs will be funded mainly from Parish Council reserves, however there is a possibility that we may be able to obtain a grant of between £5,000 and £10,000 from the County Council towards the cost of the scheme.

The next stage is for us to hold meetings, to present the options and take any questions, we are mindful that certain times of the day aren't convenient to all, so we are planning three meetings:

**Friday 6<sup>th</sup> October 2.30 pm and 7.30 pm at the Village Hall**

**Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> October 2.30 pm at the Methodist Church**

Hopefully, representatives from both Highways, SCDC and Skanska will be able to attend the meetings, with an opportunity for residents to ask questions. A large (A1) version of the plan will be available at the meeting.

We suggest that you attend one of the meetings before casting your vote.

Ballot papers can be returned to any of the Parish Councillors; details are listed overleaf.
