

## Haslingfield Parish Walk 4

Length 6.8 miles, 4 hours with a little climb up and down.

### Information

This is a walk round the village on pavements and field paths. Suitable shoes should be worn in wet weather. Dogs allowed.

See the view over Haslingfield village and Barrington Cement quarry, and walk by the River Cam.

Best to park near the Village Hall on the High Street. It is a circular walk, bringing you back to your starting point.


### Directions

Start at the Village Hall and go diagonally across the recreation ground (or turn left down the High Street and left down Porkers Lane). Follow the footpath down to the river, and cross at Burnt Mill Bridge. Continue left along the main footpath, keeping right at the split. Go through the big gate into the end of Button End, Harston. At the main road, turn right and over the road bridge over the River Cam and turn immediately left through a kissing gate to follow the riverside path. After about half a mile, the path leaves the river and turns right across the fields to Barrington. Join the end of Glebe Road and walk along to the main road, past the playground. Cross the main road to the car park and follow the path. Turn right along a footpath. Continue past Wilsmere Down Farm and up the hill to the trees at the top. Turn right along the top of the hill. You will pass the viewpoint over the cement quarry at Barrington. At the road, turn left down to Haslingfield. At the church, turn right and then down the side of the school down School Lane (private road but you can walk). Continue through the narrow bit and join Back Lane. You can take a diversion up to the quarry if you like (up Quarry Lane). Take the zigzag path opposite Quarry Lane, down to Chestnut Close, and continue straight ahead to come out by the village hall again.
